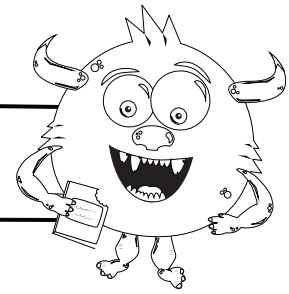


How Turtle Flew South For The Winter
